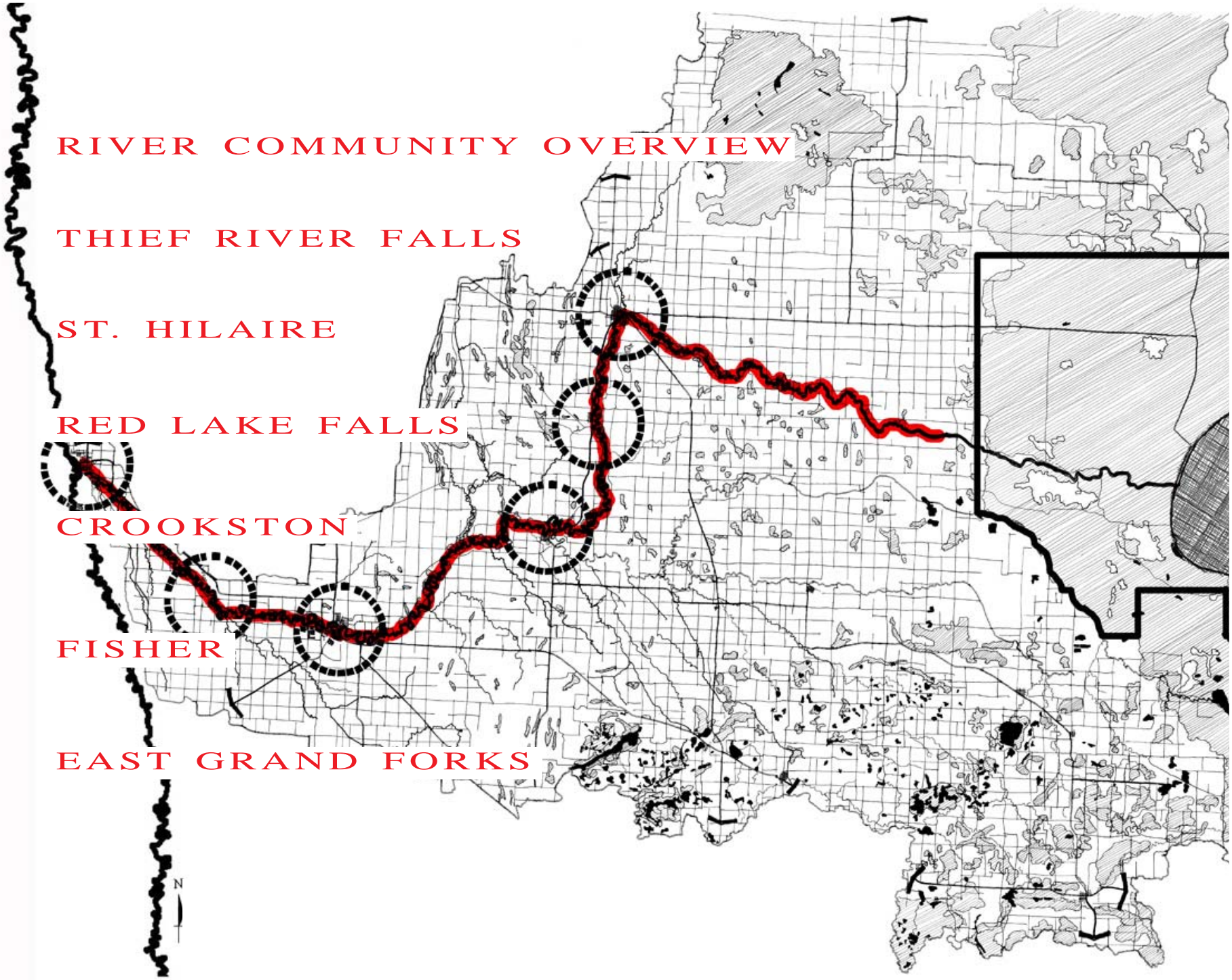

RED LAKE RIVER CORRIDOR RIVER COMMUNITY OVERVIEW

As part of the RLRCEP communities along the Red Lake River were selected for planning and design. The goal of this work is to express how the corridor plan and identity of the corridor can be fostered in each community while showing how these towns can readdress the Red Lake River. The design work focuses on improving river access, visibility, and the creation of a series of destinations along the river course. By engaging in this scale of design a set of tools have been developed that specifically show how the various communities can foster better connections to the river effectively enhancing the livability of this region. The community design work consists of:
